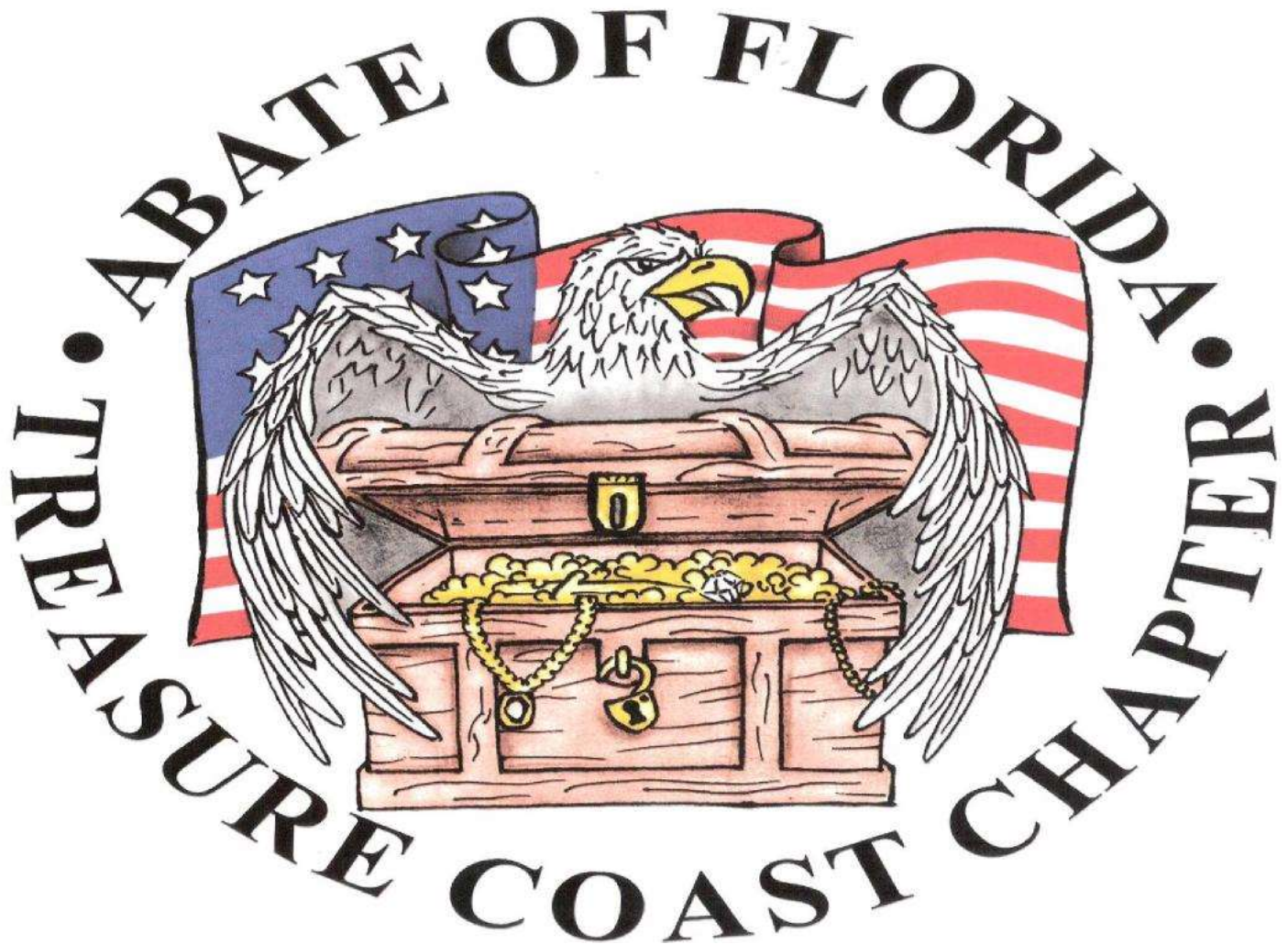

We generate revenue through these events so we can pay the lobbyist.
